DATE: 10 mile CDR, Friday, Saturday and Sunday. ***NEW*** Entries limited
15 mile CDR, Saturday, September 23. Entries limited
25 mile CTR, Friday September 22. ***NEW***
30 mile CTR, Saturday, September 23
50 mile CTR, 30 miles ridden on Saturday, 20 miles ridden on Sunday
80 mile CTR, 30 miles ridden on Friday, 30 miles ridden on Saturday, 20 miles ridden on Sunday
100 mile CTR, 40 miles ridden on Friday, 40 miles ridden on Saturday, 20 miles ridden on Sunday

LOCATION: Ride site is Fair Hill Natural Resource Area (nearest large town is Newark, DE). Terrain is rolling hunt country through woods and fields, with some gravel road. Fair Hill has excellent facilities, including bathrooms with showers, excellent stabling, plenty of flat parking.

FEES: **10/15 Mile CDR- \$50.00 (no stall) \$85.00 (with stall). 25/30-mile ride \$95.00. 50-mile ride \$155.00, 80 and 100 mile rides \$240.00.** Jrs entries offer reduced pricing. Fee includes entry, ECTRA drug fee, light breakfast, on-trail beverages, Friday and Saturday dinners and stall with one bale of straw. Extra straw will be available on site at cost.

STABLING: ALL HORSES ENTERED IN CTRs MUST BE STABLED. A **separate** stall deposit check for \$25.00 must be included with the entry. **This check will be returned or destroyed when your stall is stripped, swept, inspected, and your ride evaluation is turned in.**

FOOD: Friday, Saturday, Sunday breakfast, on-trail beverages and Saturday dinner provided to all riders. Sunday lunch is leftovers. **THURSDAY DINNER YOU ARE ON YOUR OWN. Friday dinner for all riders will be pot luck with Chesapeake providing the main course. PLEASE BRING A DISH TO SHARE.**

AWARDS: Completion awards to all riders finishing the course in the prescribed time and upon completion of final vetting. Grand and Reserve Champion awards, ribbons for placing and Junior awards. If you wish to sponsor an award, please indicate so on your entry blank; any item or a donation would be greatly appreciated.

ELIGIBILITY: CTRs open to all equines 5 years (60 months) of age or older. Horses entered in CDRs may be 4 years (48 months) or older. Current negative Coggins may accompany entry or be provided at check-in. We recommend that rabies vaccines are current. Entries accepted by mail only.

CHECK-IN: **25/80/100 milers**, September 21st at 3 pm. **30/50-milers**, September 22nd at 1 pm.

VETTING: **25/80/100 milers** vet September 21st, starting around 5 pm and ending by 7 pm.
30/50 milers vet September 22nd, starting around 2:30 pm and ending by 7 pm. No a.m. vetting except for CDR riders. ***All animals must be on the grounds by 6pm or risk disqualification.***

RIDE BRIEFING: 6:30 pm (or as soon as all horses are vetted in) September 21st, (80/100) and September 22nd (15/30/50), by the office trailer.

JUDGING: In accordance with the rules and regulations of ECTRA (Eastern Competitive Trail Riding Association). **It is the rider's responsibility to know these rules.** Rulebooks are available from Marilyn Miles, PO Box 76, Clarksville, NY 12041.

FARRIER: Most probably will not be available. Any type shoes or Easyboots may be used; pads are optional. **Please read understand ECTRA's rule regarding Easyboots or AHP.** SHOES ARE STRONGLY RECOMMENDED.

DISQUALIFICATION: Will occur if any rider is found riding anywhere other than the marked trail; for use of any drugs before, during or after the ride prior to final judging; at the discretion of management or judges should a situation warrant. See ECTRA handbook pertaining to disqualification. **Any horse requiring treatment of any kind, or any horse that the judges deem necessary to treat and the rider/owner refuses treatment will be disqualified.** Management retains the right to drug test each day.

TIME: Ride time Friday for 25 miles is 4:10 – 4:40 hours; ride time Friday and Saturday for 30 miles is 5-5:30 hours; ride time Friday and Saturday for 40 miles is 6:40 –7:10 hours, ride time Sunday for 20 miles is 2:45-3 hours. Riders more than 30 minutes early or late will be disqualified.

TRAIL: Will be marked with surveyor's tape, arrows and signs. Mileage markers will appear every 5 miles and each mile for the final 5 miles. Halfway hold will be beside the barns in the field. **Canopies are recommended as there is no shade in this area.**

TRAIL CONDUCT: Riders should ask to pass only if safe to do so, and should avoid passing at a canter or a gallop. Red ribbons in tails of kickers; yellow ribbons in tails of stallions.

MISCELLANEOUS: No pleasure riding on trails during the ride except for drag riders. Dogs must be on a leash at all times. Rider should provide own buckets, hay nets, feed and hay and grooming items. No leg protection or bandages. No internal or external medications allowed; ***note that Vicks, Swat cream and Vaseline fall into this category.*** Fly repellents, electrolytes, grooming products and water at ordinary temperatures may be used. ***NO HOSING OF HORSES ALLOWED.*** ASTM/SEI approved hard hats are mandatory and must be used whenever mounted. ***NO BAREBACK RIDING.***

REFUNDS: For cancellations before **September 18, 2017**, only the \$25.00 deposit will NOT be refunded. For cancellations after **September 18, 2017** no refunds. If entries warrant, a waiting list will be maintained; refunds are contingent on your place being filled from the waiting list. Refunds will be mailed after the ride.
