



Eastern Competitive Trail Ride Association August 2016

Last month I asked members to please send news, and actually got a large number of comments and news items, most of them giving glowing reports of the Brookfield rides on June 25th and 26th. Here are just a few of the comments:

From Linda LeVitre: "Oh my gosh, it was like the old NY 100 days! Place was wonderful. Camping, cabins and heard trails were the best. Everyone had a fantastic time. 65 riders. I'm in for next year!! I scribed, was tired but so happy to see such a fun ride again."

From Mary Coleman: "350 miles and 6+ hours later arrived at Pure Country Campground swearing that Mary Coleman was not driving this far for a ride again! But then when I rode the awesome, well marked trails with tons of volunteers and H2O set out galore, I was rethinking this. The campground manager was one of the nicest ones I have ever been around. Also management got us out on trails at 6 a.m. this makes a big difference when cooling a Morgan! Food was plentiful and good and the whole weekend was well worth the trip. Therefore [I] will be back! Thanks to all that helped. Mark your calendars for next year I highly recommend this ride."

From Deb Fisk (Edited for length) "From start to finish, good cheer passed on to everyone as we entered the grounds of "Pure Country Campground". Jim was a delight and a great host with an uncanny sense of humor. For those wondering, the Brookfield 50 & 30 along with a 15 CDR (Conditioning Distance Ride) was held June 24-26, 2016 with trails winding through the Brookfield State Forest which we were told NY owned 10,000 acres with new camp site at Pure Country Campground, in New Berlin, New York. Directions were clear, with a warm welcome to Pure Country Campgrounds by the owner, Jim Weidman. "We mowed the hayfield, so park as you like in the field to the left"; the space was wide open.

The center building is a nifty welcome center that has a lovely western atmosphere: "pure country", with air conditioning and zippy country tunes. The hospitality was down home to say the least. There were showers and an ample place to park yourself if it was too warm outside. I immediately knew we were going to have a great time.

Pre-ride exams were Friday afternoon between 3-6 pm for the 30 and 50 riders/horses. The vetting was done in grand style. Nick Kohut, Vet Judge and Eva Norris, Lay Judge vetted horses in a remarkable manner, clear, concise and quick. This was followed by a pot luck dinner and pre-ride briefing. The briefing was detailed; Dan didn't miss a beat. Emergency numbers were given to anyone who wanted to have them, and an introduction to the trails was announced by the New York Horse Council promoting their organization. The Council continues to upkeep the trails and promote wide use by keeping the trails alive and well. Please consider joining, members can make a difference to what happens to these

It was also noted in the briefing that Pure Country holds events there all season. It's a great place to ride and camp; they welcome anyone who wishes to visit and ride there.

Due to rather warm conditions, they released the first riders at 6 am both mornings. Saturday was for the 30 and 50 mile riders, Sunday was the finish of the 50 along with the 15 mile riders for the CDR.

Trails were incredible. This year Mother Nature was kind so there few wet spots. We also had a light winter so that might have helped. Trails were technical in some places; I'd probably rate it for a 2-3 out of 10 on trail toughness. The first day was mostly trail with some dirt roads. Markings were clear; there was plenty of time to make a turn so if you missed the first set of double markers, you would catch the next set directly after the first. Hills were gentle. Snacks were plentiful at the hold with more volunteers than I've seen with big smiles and offers to hold your horse. Thirty miles was covered day one, and most of this was in the woods so despite the hot weather, it was reasonable. Day two was a little more difficult but with still delightful trails with a little more dirt road mixed in. There were a little more hills, too. We also had to make time as it was 20 miles and time was 2:45 to 3 hours to complete. It was still a nice quick morning ride. We had time to walk in a number of stretches. Water was ample on trail from natural resources to water troughs. Volunteers seemed to line the trail...every time you turned around there seemed to be help at many of the corners. And the farrier turned up in many spots to help riders that lost a shoe.

The last day went by too quickly. We were onn trail in record time before the heat set in. Final vetting out was done in a central location. This meant your pulse was done near the area as well and much of this was in the sun but if you were a planner, you could set up a canopy or you could walk your horse over to a more shaded spot under the tree line then prepare to walk a short ways to the pulse volunteers and then on to the vet for your trot out. Everyone seemed to be in great spirits despite the heat.

A nice meal and awards were started as soon as we finished. A list of the donors were posted. Thanks to Jim Weidman, owner/manager, Lorraine La Hart PCC, Mary Coleman for awards, Barry and Louise Schimel for the 50 mile CTR GC, Badger Retreat Farm for the 30 mile GC, Wendy Soucy, Jo & Bill Lasher for the Program Booklet and secretary supplies and I know Eva Norris did many of the extras with awards for the 15 mile, had crochet sponge bags and many other treats. It was such a wonderful array of awards.

This ride was finished in record time for the number of riders participating. Many had time to pack and be on the road for travel home by 1pm. Surely a ride to put on your ride card for next year. Thank you all for such a successful, memorable experience."

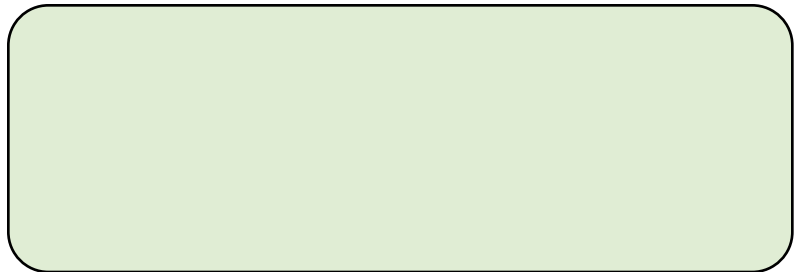
