HAPPY NEW YEAR, EVERYONE!

As we did last year, we are mailing out via USPS the relevant items for the ECTRA Annual Winter Getaway, the elections, and the Candidate resumes, plus the ballot. The full issue will go out to all members, since most of it is essential anyway; if you have internet access, you will also get the entire issue as an e-mail attachment, but without the ballot. The entire issue will also be available on-line at the ECTRA website.

Deadline for the reservations for the ECTRA events is January 20th. Deadline for the hotel reservation group rate was Jan. 5th.

VOTING PROCEDURES

Your ballot is contained in this newsletter!

All adult members of ECTRA during the 2015 year are eligible to vote. These are the same procedures we have used for many years. Please read the directions carefully. Every year, some mail-in ballots cannot be counted because the sender did not follow the directions. Remember : **if you are mailing your ballot, your name(s) must be on the return address area on the outside of the envelope.** It will still be a secret ballot because the envelope is not opened until the day the ballots are counted -- we just need your name(s) so we can check you off on the master membership list. (No one can vote twice, because if you send a ballot by mail, your name is checked off; if you come to the meeting and try to vote again, you cannot cast a ballot because your name has already been crossed off.)

OPTION I: You may vote in person. Individuals get one vote; a family membership gets two. Bring your ballot(s) with you on Saturday, Feb 6th - the ballot box will be available until 2 P.M. When you cast your ballot, your name will be checked off

on the membership list. If you forget to bring it, you will be given another.

OPTION II: You may vote by mail.

A. **You MUST print your full name** (two names if you have a family membership) **LEGIBLY** on the return address area of the envelope. The names will be checked off the membership list as soon as they are received, but the envelopes will not be opened until the votes are counted by the ballot committee at the close of voting at 2 PM Saturday. **If your ballot does not have the name(s) on the outside, it will not be counted.** Mailing it in an envelope from your work or business? Be sure your own name(s) are on the outside of the envelope.

B. DO NOT - I REPEAT, DO NOT MAIL THE BALLOT AND BANQUET RESERVATION IN THE SAME ENVELOPE!!

You must send them separately, because the ballots are not opened until the Annual Meeting on Saturday. You need one envelope for the ballot, another for the weekend reservations. If you mail them together, your reservation will not be received in time. Mark "BALLOT" prominently on the envelope with your ballot inside and make sure your name(s) appear in the return address area. Mail to the address on the ballot in time to arrive by Thursday, Feb. 4th. Late ballots will not be counted.

Last year there were two or three people that mailed both together, in spite of the 18-point, bold-faced type above. When all else fails, read the directions!

CANDIDATE RESUMES

Candidate for President: Dr. Nick Kohut, DVM: Dr. Kohut is a 1990 graduate of The Ohio State University. He has been involved in ECTRA for going on 23 years over which time he has judged more than 200 competitive trail rides in all except 3 of the states in which ECTRA sanctions rides.

He has served multiple terms as a member of the ECTRA board of directors and is the current president of the organization.

Dr. Kohut is also involved with the American Endurance Riding Conference. He is currently serving his second 2 year term as one of the NE directors. He is a member of both the Veterinary and Welfare of the Horse committees.

Between CTRs and endurance rides, he currently works 15 to 20 rides a year.

He is a part owner in Gap Veterinary Associates, Inc. The practice is the oldest still operating large animal practice in the state of Pennsylvania. It has been in service since the early 1920's.

"I bring a wealth of experience and insight to the board which I hope is helpful to the organization".

Candidate for Vice President- Wanda Stazick: "Thank you for your support over my past terms on the board. I would be happy to serve the membership for a second term as Vice President. I have been involved with ECTRA for over 18 years and have managed and volunteered at many rides during this time.

I feel that ECTRA is looking to its future with CDR and P/F divisions as they are both excellent ways to promote the sport to new individuals and increase participation at events.

" I have been working with our local agricultural commission to introduce trail riding and ECTRA to the community. This awareness has helped in the community mapping local trails and promoting that all are welcome to use these trails and better understanding on the trails. I feel that competitive trail and endurance are separate sports each with their own rules. Competitive trail's high standards and detail to

horsemanship have started many of the top endurance riders. Competitive trail riding is a partnership and bond between horse and rider which ECTRA promotes. I hope to see you out on trail in 2016."

Candidate for Secretary - Lindsey Cooke: "In the fall of 2004 I competed in my first CTR at the Chesapeake Fall ride. The following month my Appendix QH mare won novice horse at the Lick Ridge Challenge CTR and I was hooked. Some of the years between then and now found me horseless, but I didn't let that stop me from volunteering at rides and finding a way to give back to ECTRA. The past several seasons, in addition to competing, I found myself volunteering to P&R, mark & unmark trail, driving the "pick-up" rig to collect horses and riders out on trail that just were not having a good day, and donating prizes to lessen the stress on ride managers. I also enjoy mentoring new riders in our sport.

"In 2014 and 2015 I volunteered as ride secretary for the Muckleratz CTR in Halifax PA. Organizing entry forms, breed awards, starting lists, rider packets and making sure that everyone gets to start with their friends is a complicated task with nearly 100 riders entered in 5 rides. All of my time behind the scenes as a secretary has convinced me that there is nothing more important than giving back to our sport. A few months ago I was asked if I was interested in running for the ECTRA secretarial position. Keeping the minutes and taking notes at Board meetings would be an exciting and challenging new way for me to continue to give back to ECTRA.

"Additionally, as a board member, providing you, the members, with the details of our meetings will be as important to me as presenting your thoughts and concerns to the board. I hope the 2016 ride season see us growing and evolving to what our members want it to be." Safe and happy trails, Lindsey Cooke #2907.

Candidates for Board of Directors - two (2) to be elected: (in alphabetical order)

I also serve as trail master for a volunteer crew of 20+ persons who meet every Monday year round. We have responsibility for trail development **P.3**

and maintenance at five Preserves which occupy some 2,000 acres owned by Saratoga PLAN (a county land trust).

“Obviously, I have a strong interest and experience in protecting and developing equine trails. I am also interested in recruiting new persons to participate in CTR and Endurance rides. And, I bring to ECTRA 50 years of experience working with volunteers and administering not-for-profit organizations. I look forward to serving on the ECTRA Board.
