EQUINE AFFAIRE

ECTRA members participated in a presentation and question/answer session at the MA Equine Affaire in November. Patti Brooks arranged for this opportunity. Kat Waters did a wonderful job with the main presentation, using a Powerpoint slide show, and several video clips, and her terrific sense of humor. Members Wanda Stazick, Joan Hiltz, Jim and Esther Fiddes sat on the q/a panel, and answered questions from the very interested audience. Questions centered around preparation of a horse for CTR, choosing a horse for distance work, use of electrolytes, what was and was not allowed, and participation of juniors. Questions were still coming when we ran out of time! Several folks continued conversations outside the session

room. These people seemed very interested in CTR, and hopefully this presentation will encourage some new folks to try our wonderful sport!



FILM REVIEW

Bill & Jo Lasher sent a very interesting film review. Some of you may remember that we ran a series of articles a couple of years ago by a woman who participated in this event; she contacted some ECTRA members for information on distance riding and actually did some ECTRA rides on a borrowed horse.

“All The Wild Horses”

“Imagine if you can, the “tasks” of Ride Manager, Ride Secretary, Trail Master, Judge, Veterinarian, Scribe, Timer, Horse Ambulance Driver, P&R volunteer, Water stop crew, Farrier, and of many other volunteers - plus the riders, their crews and the horses - for a 650 miles, 8 days and nights competitive trail ride across the Gobi Desert in Mongolia.

“To help your imagination, a documentary film “All The Wild Horses” had its North American premiere on October 3rd, 2017 at the Aspen Film

Festival (where we enjoyed seeing it) and will soon be released and hopefully shown at a theater near you. We recommend it.

“The crew for this film follows a group of international riders, mounted on Mongolian horses, participating in the Mongol Derby, the world’s longest, and perhaps most difficult, horse race. The riders followed a GPS route along the way, bedding down with nomadic families or at horse stations on a course based on Genghis Khan’s postal service system. Riders change horses about every 50 miles along the way, keeping the horses fresh and healthy.

“The scenery is beautiful as are the Mongolian families that supply the horses and provide housing and meals for riders and volunteers along the way.

“If viewing the film inspires you to put this ride on your “bucket list”, the next ride is August 5-17, 2018. Google: The Mongol Derby” for ride costs (airfare plus \$13,000 entry fee for the use of 25-27 horses, a Mongolian crew to provide support, housing and meals, a 3-day pre-ride briefing/training event, and the use of a GPS tracking device to keep you on the route) and the application form.”

Secretary’s Report – Correction to the minutes from July 23, 2017 as published in the ECTRA newsletter is completed (Char voting on FB wording, Joan abstaining). The corrected minutes were approved by Wanda Stazick, Esther Fiddes, Ellen Tully, Dr. Joan Hiltz, Char Jewell, Bill Lasher, Katie Vogel, Rebecca Wachtel, and Jeannette Cole. There were no dissenting votes.

Treasurer’s Report – As of October 17, 2017, the money market fund is \$39,183.21 and the checking account is \$17,474.56. The Kathy Brunjes grant fund is \$3259 and NY trail repair fund is \$1933. The P&L statement is negative year on year (YOY) because lab fee expense is higher in 2017 than it was in 2016 and horse registration down in 2017 versus 2016. Ellen Tully announced to the BOD that she wouldn’t be seeking re-election in 2018. **MOTION: TO ACCEPT TREASURER’S REPORT AS SUBMITTED** (Esther Fiddes); 2nd (Katie Vogel). Wanda Stazick, Esther Fiddes, Ellen Tully, Dr. Joan Hiltz, Char Jewell, Bill Lasher, Katie Vogel, Rebecca Wachtel, and Jeannette Cole voted yes. No dissenting votes.

Committee Reports: Driving, Events Reps, Event Volunteers, Honorees, Judge Certification & Evaluation, Judge Testing, Protest, Ride Manager, Star Rating, Trail Preservation, and Veterinary Committees had nothing to report.

2018 Annual Meeting: Char Jewell – The annual meeting will be held Feb 23 – 25, 2018 in Grantville, PA. Char has begun communications with the hotel regarding meals and room costs. No budget has been developed at this time. She has contacted Dr. Hal Schott MSU professor (clinical interests include all types of urinary tract disease in horses, and his research focuses on fluid and electrolyte physiology, especially with prolonged endurance exercise) and Joyce Harmon (Lyme disease, saddle fitting). Becca Wachtel is responsible for organizing vendors for the event. Three vendors are confirmed and she is working to obtain participation of several other local vendors. Amanda Stazick is organizing the silent auction and door prizes. Several companies have been contacted. There was discussion regarding the cost of the event and assuring that the ticket prices offset the expenses associated with the meals and room. **MOTION: APPROVE NOT TO EXCEED COST**

OF \$4000 FOR SPEAKER FEES FOR 2018 ANNUAL MEETING. (Bill Lasher); 2nd by Katie Vogel; Wanda Stazick, Esther Fiddes, Dr. Joan Hiltz, Char Jewell, Bill Lasher, Katie Vogel, Rebecca Wachtel, and Jeannette Cole voted yes. Ellen Tully voted no.

Equine Affaire: Wanda Stazick – Kat Waters and an ECTRA member panel will be presenting (Stop Going in Circles; Learn the Basics of Competitive Trail Riding) at Equine Affaire at 3 pm on Sunday, November 12, 2017. The preparations are going well. Wanda reviewed the slide deck with the BOD. She is still looking for additional updated pictures to incorporate in the deck.

Mileage, Points & Awards: Esther Fiddes – The end of November starts the work in earnest.

Sanctioning: Wanda Stazick – have not sanctioned any new rides yet. There was an insurance claim at for an incident at the Chesapeake Ride. The ride had obtained their own insurance.

Old Business

1. Wording of the Decade Award to be included in 2018 rule book (Esther Fiddes) – COMPLETED AUGUST 2017
2. Updating of the judges' test to reflect rule changes and to improve the questions on the test that appear to be ambiguous. HOLD on this item until after the 2018 rulebook is published.
3. Decision on Bill's recommendation regarding email usage. Bill Lasher presented the information on this topic. We will adopt best practices in regards to voting by email (each BOD member will sign a copy of their email vote and send it to the secretary for filing). Some recommendations regarding typo changes to the membership and BOD meetings were discussed. The decision on this topic was TABLED until the February 2018 meeting.
 - i. New Business:
 - ii. Discussion on Star Rating program was held. Star rating is our only vehicle for feedback to ride managers and to the board regarding improvements and statistics for each sanctioned ride. The BOD would like to see reporting regarding the rides. **P. 3**

iii. Mileage for CDRs – Discussion regarding the distance of CDRs – only mileage from 10 to 15 miles is permitted under CDR. If the mileage is more than this the mileage goes back to 15 miles.

1. Ride /Day Manager – manager is listed at time of sanctioning; manager holds liability if a day manager is assigned.
2. Sanctioning Drug Fees – request to revert to old way of remittance of drug fees.
Current= wait until after the ride to send in drug fees; if don't get the money, results are not posted and ride will not be sanctioned for the following year.
Past = fees based on past years horse #s and then reconciled after the ride is completed.
Proposed = develop a flow sheet and decision tree for this process so that all parties are aware of their responsibilities. Jeannette will call Beth to work on this assignment. For now, the drug fee remittance will remain as current calculation.
4. Chesapeake Ride –Wanda did an investigation and reported the findings to the board, which we reviewed as a group. Follow up with educational material for the newsletter “Know your rule book” segment. Topics for the upcoming newsletters could include: What does ECTRA sanctioning mean; how are ride day awards determined; how are end of year awards determined; what is the underlying philosophy for the ECTRA rule book.
5. Electronic Scoring – No further money will be invested in this program. If there is a member interested in championing the electronic scoring program the board welcomes your leadership. Wilson Ring is available for tutoring.
6. Refusal to accept an entry – It is the ride manager's responsibility to determine this criteria.
7. Approval of Rule Changes for 2018 – Jeannette will summarize the document and send it out to the BOD for review at the December 11, 2017 phone meeting.
8. Number of riders permitted during a ride on a single horse – This topic was briefly discussed. **TABLED** for more clarification and time for input (mileage awarded at the time of substitution, criteria for substitution, how many substitutions, distance allowed for substitution).
9. Rookie Horse Perpetual Award - A proposal was submitted to begin a rookie horse award in honor of LBF Hickory Smoke. The award would be presented at the annual meeting each year to the rookie horse/pony of any breed who has accumulated the most ECTRA competitive trail riding points in the competition year. It will be the winner's responsibility to engrave the trophy with the correct information, hold the trophy for the year and return it to the awards chairperson to be presented in the subsequent year. **MOTION: to accept the proposal to start the LBF Hickory Smoke Award beginning in 2017.** (Katie Vogel); 2nd Bill Lasher. Wanda Stazick, Ellen Tully, Dr. Joan Hiltz, Char Jewell, Bill Lasher, Katie Vogel, Rebecca Wachtel, and Jeannette Cole voted yes. Esther Fiddes recused herself from voting.

MEET OUR SEMINAR SPEAKERS

Dr. Harold Schott, DVM, PhD, DACVIM - Dr. Hal Schott earned a bachelor's degree from Cornell in 1980 and a DVM from the Ohio State University in 1984. He worked in a private equine practice in Santa Barbara, Calif., from 1984 to 1987 and followed that with a residency and PhD program at Washington State University from 1987 to 1991. He was on the WSU faculty from 1991 to 1995 as an instructor and then an assistant professor of equine internal medicine. In 1995, he came to Michigan State University as an assistant professor and progressed to associate and then full professor. He is a Diplomate of the American College of Veterinary Internal Medicine.

His clinical interests include all types of urinary tract disease in horses, and his research focuses on fluid and electrolyte physiology, especially with prolonged endurance exercise. Dr. Schott's name is synonymous with electrolyte education in the endurance world. He has performed numerous studies and supported out sport for many years.

Dr. Joyce Harman, DVM, MRCVS – Many ECTRA members are familiar with Dr. Harman who participated in and supported ECTRA for many years. Dr. Harman graduated from Virginia Maryland Regional College of Veterinary Medicine in 1984 with an interest in acupuncture and alternative medicine.

Dr. Harman became a Certified Veterinary Acupuncturist in 1990. She decided to open her own practice and do just acupuncture, so she moved to Virginia in 1990 and opened Harmany Equine Clinic. In 1994 she became a Certified Veterinary Chiropractor and also completed an advanced homeopathic course for veterinarians. Along the way she has taken many other courses in holistic medicine for animals.

Dr. Harman is well known as an expert on tick borne diseases, she regularly consults with veterinarians and owners across the country for treatment protocols.

She has "written the book" on saddle fitting, with two volumes, The Horse's Pain Free Back and Saddle Fit Book for western and English horses. She also has a booklet to help introduce people to homeopathy for horses, The First Aid Guide to Homeopathy for Horses. Her goal is to help educate the equine industry about natural, holistic and integrative medicine.

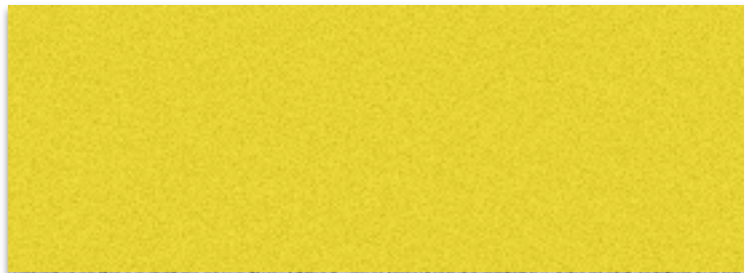
