**ECTRA ANNUAL GETAWAY, FEB 23 -25
GRANTVILLE, PA**

Over one-third of the membership attended this year's Annual Meeting and Awards celebration. The speakers were very well received, although it was suggested at the Annual Membership Meeting that the sessions could be shortened somewhat. Board member and organizer Char Jewell has contracted with top speakers the last two years and the cost is reflected in an increased speaker budget.

Given the time, effort and expense to organize the weekend, President Wanda Stazick posed the question to the membership: "What do you think this format should be going forward?". A suggestion was to offer webinars. Admitting she wasn't tech savvy, Mary Coleman chimed in "WEBINARS! Sounds like a duck to me". Others chimed in that they wouldn't bother to drive six plus hours for a webinar; they wanted a live speaker.

While we sometimes feel the turn out isn't what we'd like - we actually had over a 1/3 of the membership attend. Former President Dr. Nick Kohut said that AERC doesn't get that percentage of their membership so we should be well pleased. It should be pointed out however, that AERC is a national organization while we are regional. What we typically do see is that when the Getaway is in the southern part of the region, the attendance is higher. Beth Sheldon and Esther Fiddes had the organization of the awards well in hand for the evening, and Patti Lambert gets thanks for ride entry data feed to Beth, then Esther, a team effort to make this possible. Other board members lending a hand were Katie Vogel and Dr. Hiltz. Amanda Stazick did a fantastic job on the Silent Auction, raising about \$1400, thanks to generous donations from our membership ; she had help from Phoebe Jewell when it came time to pick door prize tickets. Mary and Katie raised a good amount with then 50/50 raffle. Board member Bill Lasher opened Saturday's banquet with a wonderful blessing and President Wanda Stazick turned the evening's proceedings over to Emcee Dr. Art King who was handling this job for the first time, and did very well. Lindsey Cooke received the Jane Soule Award Volunteer of the Year Award and Jo Steele of New Hampshire was named ECTRA Honorary Member for all her behind the scenes work through the years in transitioning us from paper to electronic and more recently through Committee Chair changes.

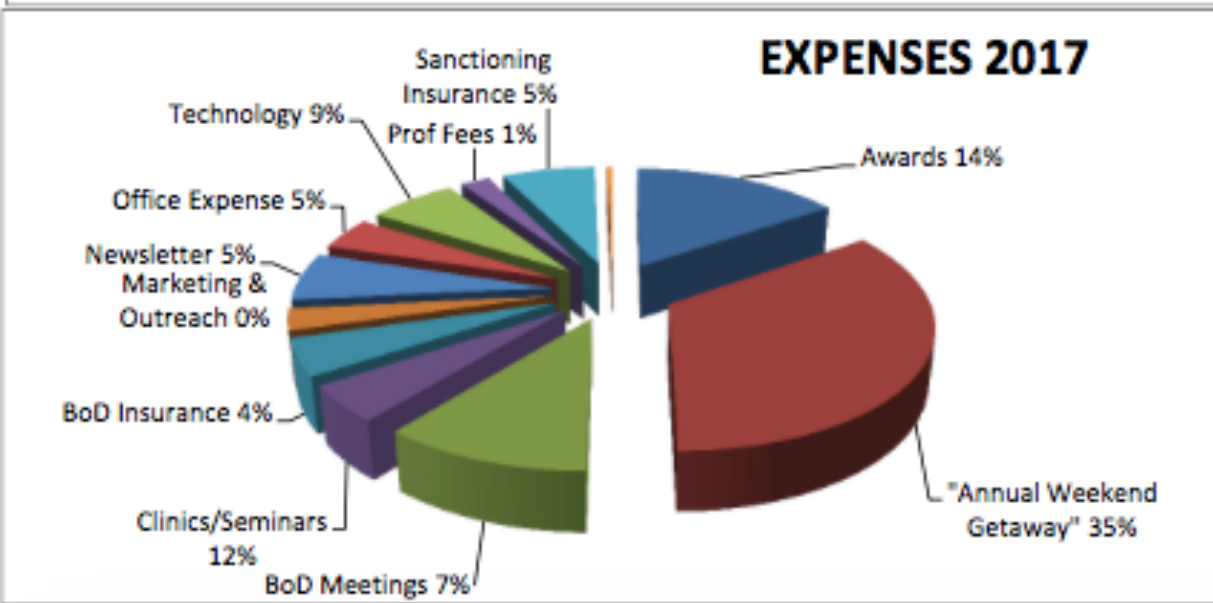
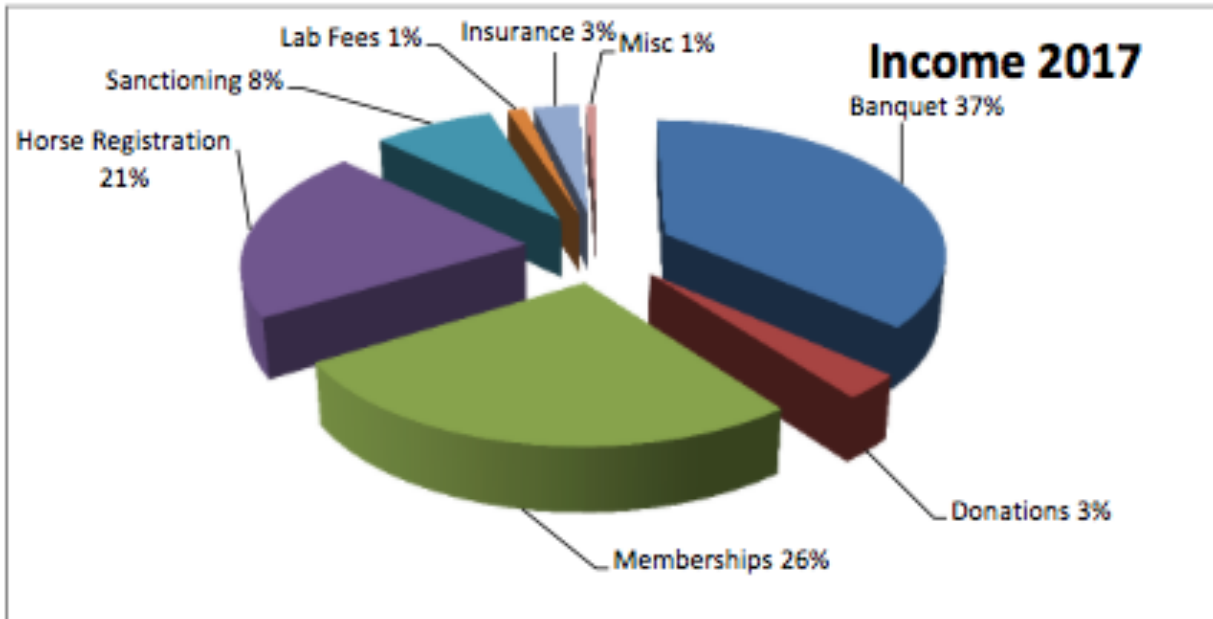

ANNUAL MEETING – Char Jewell - 2017 Annual Meeting

Fabulous turnout with the speakers presenting, Dr. Susan Garlinghouse, John Crandell and Dr. Kristen Bubeck from Tufts. 82 people for Friday, 98 for Saturday, 90 for the Banquet, 85 for Sunday.

DRIVING – Jenny Kimberly - Not much to report. Not many drivers. All went well with those that we had.

DRUG TESTING – Dr. Nick Kohut, Dr. Joan Hiltz - This year the committee tested three rides for a total of 11 samples. This amounts to just under 1% of the total number of horses competing in competitive trail events. Our testing lab, Dalare Associates, charged \$75 to ship out each testing kit and \$85 per sample for a total of \$1,085.00. Return shipment costs were \$117.76. Total costs were \$1,277.76. Based on the number of entries this past year (868), we should be able to test an additional ride in 2018.

There were no positive test results.

A reminder to all that the purpose of our testing program is to deter competitors from using non-approved substances on their equines. It is not meant to try and catch those people. To do that ECTRA would need to test a large percentage of competitors at a very high cost.

EQUINE AFFAIRE – Wanda Stazick - ECTRA was contacted by Equine Affair in the summer of 2017 asking if we would like to present in November 2017 in Springfield, MA. It was at no cost to ECTRA, so we accepted. In November Kat Waters made the presentation with a panel available for questions including Joan Hiltz, Jim and Esther Fiddes and Wanda Stazick. It was well received considering that our time slot was 3 pm on Sunday afternoon. At this time we have not had any communication with Equine Affair for 2018.

EVENT REPS – Vickie Smith- there was one event rep report regarding clarification of rules, which was addressed by the BOD. I continue to encourage ride managers to be sure they identify an event representative at their rides and file reports to me.

EVENT VOLUNTEERS – Helen Stacy

Since its inception in 1991, the Volunteer Worker Mileage Program has **71 workers and 99,368 accumulated miles**. It can take an average of one worker per rider to put on a competitive trail ride. We really appreciate our volunteers – did you know that if you help at a multi-day ride you would receive maximum mileage even if you could help only one day? Those miles will tally up fast!

There are many more ECTRA members volunteering out there so remember to send in your mileage to me on a regular basis and be recognized and earn your belt buckle! It's a great way to get friends and family involved in the sport too. We want to share in the fun and camaraderie!

In 2007, there was an award started in memory of one of our founders, the “Jane Soule Volunteer Award. At the banquet, part of the Soule family was presented with a mantle clock inscribed with: “Jane Soule 2007 Volunteer Award for her Extraordinary Commitment to our Trail Riding Association”. Each year, the Volunteer Chair presents name(s) to the ECTRA BOD for their vote on who deserves this award. Let me know of your choice for this award in the coming year and why. The person must be a current ECTRA member but is not required to be active in ECTRA’s volunteer mileage program.

JUDGE CERTIFICATION & EVALUATION & TESTING - Dr. Nick Kohut, Louise Lester, Eva Norris, Terry Buckley
Once again, this was a rather quiet year for the committee. There were no new judges taking the judging exam. A few judges retook the exam to maintain their certification. There were twenty-two different events. Ride managers employed nine different veterinary judges (out of forty-six on the current list) and eleven different lay judges (out of thirty-nine). We received forty mail-in judge evaluation sheets (see distribution below). There were no specific complaints and many compliments.

AWARDS, MILEAGE & POINTS – Esther Fiddes

Awards (Esther & Beth): Overall, the Awards process has run very smoothly this year. In summary:

- The SOP created last year is being utilized.
- Once the P&M results were received, the notification process and ordering of awards was completed in approximately 10 days.
- We have used the same vendors as last year for ordering, engraving and embroidery of the awards.
- The new 2016 awards were extremely well received.
- We continue to enhance and add awards. New this year is a beautiful etched crystal bowl for the Florida Cup, and a beautiful perpetual Rookie Horse Award.

Unfortunately, completion of the P&M tabulation took longer than planned, which resulted in a rush to notify members of their awards and receive their replies to allow the award orders to be placed with sufficient time before the banquet.

Hopefully the P&M process will run smoother next year, which will further improve the awards process.

The biggest issue confronted by Awards this year was the number of missing or incorrect email addresses, which made notifying members problematic and required additional time and effort to track down a valid email address. We would ask that steps be taken to update members email address in the database as it is our primary means of communicating with them.

Points & Mileage (Beth)

This was the first year that I completed the entire P&M process and provided the results for the Awards process. I had only the 2016 ride results, 2016 rider and horse total mileage and a copy of some of Greg's awards paperwork to use as a reference. There was no SOP to follow only the ECTRA Rule Book. As a result, the lack of documentation did have an impact in completing all the requirements previously performed by Greg. However, what information I did have from Greg was very helpful in being able to get started.

As a first step, the paper ride reports were redesigned as online spreadsheets to collect the ride results and ride summary information. The same information was collected in the new online spreadsheets. These spreadsheets were distributed to ride managers (RM's) and were available on the ECTRA website. A trial version of the spreadsheet was available for NJTRA's March rides, Rabbit Run and Bunny Hop. Feedback was positive and the sheets have been used but we need more RM's to use them and fully complete them.

In agreeing to take on the P&M role, my primary objective had been to work on the backend process, updating the database with Jo Steele. Instead my focus has been on the front end process. There have been numerous challenges this year in collecting all the ride results in preparation for calculating horse and rider points & mileage. Most notable was missing or incorrect horse and/or rider ECTRA numbers from both ECTRA and AERC rides. The ECTRA numbers are the key elements for updating the database and tabulating P&M for the Awards. Hours and hours of work was required to collect and clean up the data, research horse and rider numbers, in order to prepare the data for import to the database and be able to complete the P&M tabulations for the awards. Several updates/changes to the ECTRA Rule Book were identified during the tabulation process.

A presentation will be given at the Feb BOD meeting to review the P&M process, discuss in more detail the hurdles and challenges we've had this year, changes that need to be made in 2018 and what work still needs to be finished. Page 4

Due to the lack of an SOP or documentation for P&M, some of the work that Greg did for ECTRA was not recognized until it was needed. I was not aware of the need to supply the Newsletter with the ride results. This responsibility tipped my applecart with my other personal responsibilities. The time and effort needed to create the reports in the format Judy required took time away from the larger P&M project.

Mileage Ride Results (Patty Lambert):

Throughout the year, I received ride result reports (via email) from ride managers in the form of a spreadsheet sheet. I then transferred all of these ride results to a master spreadsheet (using Google sheets, which I shared with Beth) which contains all the rides for the year.

The standard ECTRA spreadsheet format is on the ECTRA web page and was used by most CTR ride managers. The spreadsheet includes all names, ECTRA numbers for riders and horses, placings, scores, times, numbers of starts and finishes, names of judges.

However, there was considerable difficulty/confusion when ride managers used a different spreadsheet format (often it was the AERC spreadsheet), since the transfer of data columns was in a different order and prone to errors during transfer. Therefore, we need to emphasize the importance of using the ECTRA spreadsheet format found on the web page. Another occasional glitch was when managers sent the results in PDF format, which I could not use.

A very important issue was the lack of ECTRA membership numbers on some of the reports. If numbers are not present, then members will not get credit for their rides.

Overall, considering that this was the first year using the new system, things went fairly well on my end. I would request that we require all results be submitted using the ECTRA spreadsheet format found on the web page.

NEWSLETTER – Judy Lorimer - Eleven issues of the newsletter were published in 2017: a combined January/February issue and monthly issues from March through December. There were two oversized issues this year, in March and April. The number of paper copies continues to diminish, as more and more areas of the Northeast are providing high speed Internet service -- we are down to about 45 paper copies.

The January/February issue, which is mailed out via USPS to all members because of the ballot and all the year-end ECTRA Winter Getaway information, is obviously the most expensive because of the printing and postage costs.

Some of our members have helped provide news items on a regular basis, along with great photos...keep the news coming! It makes the newsletter much more interesting. Thanks to all the committees - Sanctioning, for the monthly Events Listings; Points and Mileage, for Ride Results and Outside Mileage; and the ECTRA Secretary, for BOD minutes - that send essential information on a regular basis, as well as the other committee heads who pass on their news in a timely manner. Back in pre-computer days, I used to have to type these out on my manual typewriter; now they come to me camera-ready, which saves hours of hunt-and-peck typing!

I would like to remind Ride Managers to send me publicity information well in advance of your ride date. The deadline for all issues except Jan/Feb is the 20th of the preceding month. If you have an early season ride (e.g. April) you need to send me your publicity by February 20th, in order to get your write up into the March issue.

Thanks for your support -- my first issue was in April 1980, so 2018 will be starting my 39th year as editor. Best wishes for a terrific year on the trail!

NOMINATING- Esther Fiddes - The Nomination Committee was able to obtain top quality candidates for 2018 BOD. Many thanks to outgoing Treasurer, Ellen Tully, for her many years of service and dedication to ECTRA. Thanks also to Char Jewell and Bill Lasher for their hard work on behalf of the membership.

As always, it would be terrific if more members would volunteer to serve on the Board.

PROTEST - Cynthia Young - We had just one protest filed this year, at the end of the ride season, by Cate Peloquin. The protest arose out of an ambiguity in a written communication she received, which suggested the horse Poe would not receive MCO for the 80 miler he did at the fall Chesapeake rides, with different riders. Once it was clarified by the board that Poe, but of course not the riders, would receive credit, Cate was satisfied with the outcome and dismissed the protest. That is all I have to report for 2017.

PR & EDUCATION- Patti Brooks – no report

RIDE MANAGERS- Cate Peloquin - In a year where one of my goals was to get some continuity among rides, I encountered resistance and lack of communication among Ride Managers.

I feel strongly that as an organization we should have some consistency over the field of competition, so new riders and returning riders have some level of "what to expect".

I do wish we were able to achieve as an organization and amongst our Ride Managers, knowledge of the Rule Book and an understanding of the rules contained there-in. Appropriate interpretation of those rules by key personnel is important to our success.

Thank you ECTRA for giving me an opportunity to serve ECTRA in so many capacities. I am very hopeful another individual steps up to run this very valuable committee and can take it further and with much success!

SAFETY- Louise Lester -No reports of safety issues were sent to the Safety Committee. I have been writing a column about my experiences having to do with safety subjects for the ECTRA Newsletter, which have been well received. It is hoped that each year will bring safe and uneventful rides to every rider and their horse.

SANCTIONING- Wanda Stazick – Currently (2018) ECTRA has sanctioned 18 competitive events, 12 endurance events and 2 clinics. Confirmation emails are being sent to ride managers and secretaries for each of the rides. Included in the emails, I have included any documents I am missing to complete the sanctioning process; how to send in drug fees; and I have attached a copy of the result sheet with instructions.

STAR RATING - Ben Fangman - From an overall perspective, we held 18 rides in 2017 and all of these rides received a rating of 90% or better. Generally the novice riders are most critical with comments about ride mileage discrepancies between GPS and posted mileage (one tenth of a decimal differences in some cases), clarity of ride processes and **P.5**

more general direction of what to expect on ride day. 50 mile riders are the happiest of the respondents; appreciative to have ride managers who will host this length of ride. General comments from CDR participants are that they needed a bit more attention from a ride briefing perspective as these riders generally leave later than other riders. Overall the satisfaction ratings have improved year on year.

All star ratings have been processed and will be available near the ballot box as usual. I will be holding onto the individual evaluation sheets this year. If any ride manager wishes to have them back please contact me.

The ride evaluation sheet has been modified to reflect the misunderstandings in the rating of 1 to 5 on questions 9 through 15. Hopefully it will help, so you know, I was able to discern what people meant when they marked the wrong rating. It also has a new mail to address listed on the bottom. **Ride managers, please clear your files of the old evaluation sheets for the new one**, this will make my job easier.

Finally, I would like to start to email these reports to ride managers listed on the ride information. Please let me know if you would like to receive your reports this way.

TRAIL PRESERVATION - Dan Gruen – ADK park agency has issued a ruling on Bores Pond tract; a large section will be forever wild (no machinery or machine maintenance) another section will allow machinery for parking and trail maintenance. Possibility for horse camping in Bores Pond – no ETA. Frontier Town in North Hudson will open this summer and will include some of the eventual 30 horse camping sites as well as sites for other campers. NY State Works program has funds for DEC to do trail improvements on many multi use trails including Brookfield (replace old bridges with culverts and stone cover).
