



## *Eastern Competitive Trail Ride Association*

### *September 2018*

The competitive season is starting to wind down: the list of rides gets shorter as the steamy summer days are starting to get cooler. We hope you are well on your way to achieving any goals you might have set for yourself or your horse at the beginning of the year, and continue to learn something new with every ride you enter.

Here is some excellent advice from Brenda Senseney, longtime rider, judge, and ride volunteer:

### **Help your horse**

—observations from a judge and recorder.

*At three rides this year, I had the privilege of acting as Lay Judge or recorder. I would like to take this opportunity to share my observations in the hopes that these notes will help riders to help their horses.*

#### 1 Show your horse to its best ability.

If your horse is barefoot but uses hoof protection on trail, please take a look at the trot-out area before presenting. If it is crushed gravel or even slightly rocky, put the boots on before trot-out! If the judges want to see what's under the gaiter to examine the pastern, they can make that request at any time. (Do not show up at a vetting with bell boots or leg protection.)

#### 2 Trot-outs - PRACTICE-PRACTICE-PRACTICE at home!

Practice after EVERY conditioning ride even if it's only a straight line. Practice without a lunge whip! Am shocked to see so many riders feel the need to use a whip to start a straight line and/or to encourage circles. Give treats as a reward when they get the idea. While you're at it, use a longer line. The smaller the circle, the less likely your horse will trot or gait and will not look 100% sound either. Train yourself to walk in a smaller circle as your horse trots around you! You do not have to stay stationary while lunging; this especially helps to make larger circles.

#### 3 Sore back or girth - why?

At one ride, there was only one horse with a sore back. The rider had helped management mark trails on prior days. Even if you're a lightweight rider, the twisting weight and many stops on trail will fatigue or

sore your horses' back. Pressure bumps? Take note of any raised swellings after conditioning rides and make adjustments before coming to a competition. Having girth sores or elbow rubs? If your saddle has three billets, use the two rear billets away from the elbows. It really will make a difference!

#### 4 "Buddy-itis" – keep your horse calm

Most of us have had this problem – a nervous or panicky horse because their buddy is not with them at holds or vetting. It's OK to keep a buddy next to your horse, even if it's a horse that is not in that day's competition. Be safe and keep others around you safe too.

#### 5 Present a clean horse – please?

You're not judged on horses' cleanliness but do you want the vet to put their fingers in your horses' mouth after running their hands down the manure-or-mud-streaked hind legs (or dirty backs)? Judges do try to keep their hands disinfected between horses but try to show some respect for them, please?

#### 6 Watch out for ruts on trail.

With so much rain causing soft ground, puddles and wash-outs, try to avoid riding in car tire sized ruts. Unless your horse is very narrow or very small, he will most likely end up with open sores on the inside ankles even if he's never interfered before.

What went right: at the Muckleratz endurance ride in July with close to 100F temp in the early afternoon, **not a single horse had to be treated at the ride!** Excellent job by the veterinarians in their strict control to catch horses before they got into metabolic trouble. And excellent job by the endurance riders who knew to quit when their horses had enough or slowed down and took super care of their mounts! Congrats to all finishers!

### **RIDE SAFELY**

It's amazing that horses will even begin to load into a trailer, even a stock type. In prospective it would be like a person walking willingly into a coffin. I think it's imperative to give foals or weanlings their first ride with their "hopefully" well-mannered mothers. Having mom there is a help in keeping the foal calm and assured. However, most of us don't have that luxury of owning our horses from foalhood. After that time it's the horse's

training and willingness to obey when we ask them to load.

Most of you who are reading this have already experienced this work with our horses but some are more talented at dealing with loading. This is a very dangerous scenario and the possibility of getting hurt is great. A horse that walks up and loads calmly is a blessing but unfortunately that isn't always the case. I'm not going to try to lecture on how to load a horse only to say don't get in front or behind the loading horse. The frustration level increases for both horse and human when the horse refuses to load or unload. Here patience is the key to getting the horse in or out. Of course this leads me to encourage lots of practice for both parties so that on the day it must load, it will.

As for hauling the horse whether you tie it or not is a decision only you can determine. I've found that in a stock trailer without another horse it is great to let your horse be untied so he can determine his most comfortable stance and he can get his head down to allow for sinus drainage. If the trailer has stalls or there are other horses being hauled then it's advisable to tie them so they don't get into trouble with one another. In our stock trailer even tied one of our ponies will turn his butt toward the horse beside him and push it over crowding it. In stalls it's easier to keep them separated but here you want the horse to have as much freedom in his head to get his head down but not enough to allow for interfering with the horse next to him. This is especially true if the dividers have an additional partition at the head. If the horse is tied too long he can get his head behind the partition and get stuck. Also the horse next to him probably won't enjoy having his neighbor's head over him during the trip. I've mentioned in a previous article not to use bungee type trailer ties because they stretch and cannot be disconnected without becoming a whip during the recoil which can hurt horse and handler.

Unloading is a hazard unless the horse is trained to come out quietly. Many horses run backward from the trailer and once underway

won't stop until it is free of the trailer. Because of this be sure to untie the horse's head before opening the back door and dropping the butt guard. If you know your horse is likely to do this fasten a lunge line to him before starting the procedure running it inside the stall so that when he's clear of the trailer you will still have control of him.

My safety suggestion: Work diligently in training your horse to load and unload before you need to move him. And try to practice it early in the year so you don't get a surprise that first time you want to load for a competition.
